



## **How to install catalog (Cat) files in Planit Fusion Live Standalone**

### **Planit Fusion Live Standalone**

Open the software

Next open the software if the Select Catalog screen pops up click on Cancel.

Next click on File (in the upper left) and choose Installer

Next screen click the Add button. This will open a Look In screen

Locate the catalog (Cat) file and double click on it.

This will install the catalog.

To make sure you will need to click on the “Search for New Catalogs” button.

This will bring up a listing of all the catalogs installed.

Locate the catalog you just added and make sure the status says “Installed”

If so just click on Ok or Cancel.

If that catalog is not installed, click on the line to highlight it and click the Add button.

You may get a prompt box saying “This catalog version (Catalog short name and version number) is newer than this catalog (catalog short name and version). What you are looking for is the higher number. The way to read the numbers, for example, 502\_10 the first number is the year, the second set is the month, and the last number(s) is the version number.

Click Yes on this pop up box then click Ok.

This will take you back to the Installer screen.

Next you will need to modify the existing group or create a group if this is a new catalog you have never installed.

On the screen look to the lower left you will see Group names. If the catalog name is showing, click on the group name to highlight it and look to the right.

You will see a listing of catalogs. Make sure the Main catalog (denoted with an asterisk) is the correct one. If not locate the catalog in the upper portion of the screen.

Click on the name to highlight it and click the “Add to Group” button to the right.

Note if you are creating a new group you will need to add the Advanced graphics catalog to the group.

You also have the option of removing a catalog from the group. You will highlight it in the upper portion of the screen and click “Remove from group”.

When you are finished creating your groups click Ok to exit the Installer screen

If the Select Catalog screen does not pop up click on File and choose New.

The catalog is installed and ready to use.
